Summary: On February 2, 2017, two Iranian first time immigrants (IR5 husband and wife) arrived at Washington Dulles Airport aboard Royal Dutch Airlines (KLM) flight #651 from Amsterdam, the Netherlands. Both travelers, identified as (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) require an exemption from the Commissioner under the Presidential Executive Order "Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry to the United States (January 27, 2017). Prior to boarding, CBP Immigration Advisory Program (IAP) officers informed CBP-IAD a journalist was travelling with the couple, documenting their story. Upon arrival, the couple was met by CBP officers and escorted to primary for inspection. The journalist, who was identified as (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) - a Dutch citizen, was accompanying them as they departed the mobile lounge and entered the terminal.
