All,

See below. Read the executive order. Starting at 0500 tomorrow, all nonimmigrants and immigrants from the countries listed therein are inadmissible. LPRs may be eligible for relief from the DFO. However, we are awaiting guidance from HQ. I need the overnight shift to start sweeping flights arriving this morning. Any aliens from these countries should be detained and reported to myself and the APDs.

This is serious, I need acknowledgement from the WC and overnight sup that we are sweeping flights for these individuals. I need a list of arriving aliens from

these countries seduced to land in Atlanta at least 2 hours before they get here.

This is the executive order signed this evening by the President. It basically states that all immigrants and non-immigrant from Iraq, Iran, Sudan, Libya, Somalia, Syria, and Yemen are to be refused entry to the US.

There are exceptions to this case LPRs being one of them where S1 can authorize a waiver for the traveler. This authority for LPRs has been delegated to the DFO but (b)(7)(E) and a thorough narrative. Advanced paroles are also eligible for a waiver as well. As of now, if we encounter ANYONE FROM THE SEVEN COUNTRIES previously identified, we should (b)(7)(E) to ensure we take the appropriate action.

I am awaiting formal guidance from APP later this evening that I will provide as well. There will be a reporting requirement to OPS that will be due early in the morning on the encounters.

(b)(7)(E) are available if there are additional questions and those questions should be submitted to the Field Office's Border Security Staff.

Please review the EO and be prepared to notify your WCs, Chiefs, SCBPOs, and CBPOs of the guidance as it is effective immediately.

Furthermore; the entry into the U.S. of immigrants and nonimmigrants from these countries is suspended for 90 days from the date of this order (excluding those foreign nationals traveling on diplomatic visas, North Atlantic Treaty Organization visas, C-2 visas for travel to the United Nations, and G-1, G-2, G-3, and G-4 visas).

As such the admission of all nonimmigrants and immigrants from the countries listed therein will, until further notice be considered to be inadmissible.

Any aliens from these countries should be detained and reported to PD and the APDs.



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

The EO Crisis Action Team (CAT) is working to automate, streamline, and reduce the number of reporting periods currently required of the Field.

For today's 0500 and 1500 (EST) reports, please use the existing template and submit via email. It will not be necessary to submit a 2100 report today.

Beginning Saturday, February 4, 2017, Field Offices will only need to submit stats twice daily via SharePoint, as shown on the attached revised templates.

Guidance for use of revised templates:

The EO CAT has created a page on the Incident Management Division SharePoint site.

Beginning Saturday, February 4, 2017, reports must be submitted via the site:

Starting Saturday, February 4, 2017, reports must be submitted via SharePoint by 0001 (EST) and 1200 (EST).

In accordance with the February 1, 2017 White House Guidance, Sections 3(c) and 3(e) of the EO do not apply to Lawful Permanent Residents (LPR) returning to the United States. LPR information should not be captured on the spreadsheet.

FROM THE SEVEN COUNTRIES previously identified, (b)(7)(E) to ensure we take the appropriate action.

I am awaiting formal guidance from APP later this evening that I will provide as well. There will be a reporting requirement to OPS that will be due early in the morning on the encounters.

See below. Read the executive order. Starting at 0500 tomorrow, all nonimmigrants and immigrants from the countries listed therein are inadmissible. LPRs may be eligible for relief from the DFO. However, we are awaiting guidance from HQ. I need the overnight shift to start sweeping flights arriving this morning. Any aliens from these countries should be detained and reported to myself and the APDs.

This is serious, I need acknowledgement from the WC and overnight sup that we are sweeping flights for these individuals. I need a list of arriving aliens from these countries seduced to land in Atlanta at least 2 hours before they get here.

State and (b)(7)(E) are working to cancel visas. However, it will likely be 3 or 4 days before all individuals from these countries are out of the air. I need you to dig down and get ahead of this. Don't fail us.

This is the executive order signed this evening by the President. It basically states that all immigrants and non-immigrant from Iraq, Iran, Sudan, Libya, Somalia, Syria, and Yemen are to be refused entry to the US.

There are exceptions to this case LPRs being one of them where S1 can authorize a waiver for the traveler. This authority for LPRs has been delegated to the DFO but requires (b)(7)(E) and a thorough narrative. Advanced paroles are also eligible for a waiver as well. As of now, if we encounter ANYONE FROM THE SEVEN COUNTRIES previously identified, (b)(7)(E) to ensure we take the appropriate action.

I am awaiting formal guidance from APP later this evening that I will provide as well. There will be a reporting requirement to OPS that will be due early in the

morning on the encounters.

(b)(7)(E) are available if there are additional questions and those questions should be submitted to the Field Office's Border Security Staff.

Please review the EO and be prepared to notify your WCs, Chiefs, SCBPOs, and CBPOs of the guidance as it is effective immediately.
