Houston, TX IAH: Individuals Entry to Sterile Area (Baggage Recheck) - 02/02/2017

# **Summary:**

On February 2, 2017 U.S. Customs & Border Protection Officers (CBPOs) assigned to the George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) were advised by a United Airlines representative that four (4) individuals later identified as immigration attorneys had gain access to FIS recheck area. The individuals made it to the United ticket counter in baggage recheck and demanded to know if refugees were being detained, their identity, and the grounds for their detention. HPD was notified and the individuals were escorted out of recheck back into the arrivals area.

#### **Details:**

On Thursday, February 2, 2017, at approximately 1150 hrs. United Airlines representative notified Baggage Control Supervisor that four (4) individuals later identified as immigration attorneys had just entered the FIS recheck area (secure area) via the exit doors. The individuals went to the ticket counter in baggage recheck and asked to speak to CBP.

The individuals (attorneys) identified themselves as refugee volunteers. The airline representative believed them to be part of International Organization for Migration (IOM) assisting with refugee processing. When the United Airlines employees realized the attorneys were not authorized to be in the sterile area they directed the attorneys to leave and notified HAS operations and CBP. HPD and HAS security were notified and arrives after the individuals had departed the recheck area.

#### **Subject Information:**

No subject information was obtained as there was no interaction between CBP and the individuals. Houston Police Department addressed the violations of City Ordinance and spoke directly with the parties involved.

At no time was there any breech of the FIS/Baggage control doors.
