SUBJECT: Reporting Guidance for Actions Taken Related to Executive Order: *Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry Into the United States*

On January 27, 2017, President Donald Trump issued Executive Order: *Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States*. It is the policy of the United States to protect its citizens from foreign nationals who intend to commit terrorist attacks in the United States; and to prevent the admission of foreign nationals who intend to exploit United States immigration laws for malevolent purposes.

As we push forward in our efforts to protect our Nation, OFO Operations will require daily reporting on our activities as related to this Executive Order. Reporting will include encounters in the air, land and sea environments with anyone who arrives into the U.S. from the seven (7) countries (Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria and Yemen) that meets the criteria outlined in the Executive Order and the instructions issued to the field by Admissibility and Passenger Programs.

Using the attached spreadsheet, data should be captured daily for the 24-hour time period beginning at 0300 (EST) – and ending at 0259 hours (EST). **By 0500 hours (EST) daily**, each Field Office is required to submit their data from the previous 24-hours to OFO Field Liaison (b)(7)(E). Reports must be submitting using the attached Microsoft Excel template document. Field Liaison will consolidate these reports into a final report senior CBP and DHS leadership.

The Executive Order applies to LPRs who are citizens of the seven listed countries. The Secretary has delegated waiver authority to CBP Field Office Directors for returning LPRs.

A limited number of additional categories of travelers from the seven countries may be considered for waiver, but those waivers must be approved by our Acting Commissioner or the Secretary.

But generally speaking, all immigrant and non immigrant visas from the seven countries have been revoked and those persons are not eligible for a waiver. They will be offered the opportunity to withdraw their application for admission. Lacking passenger agreement with the withdrawal, they will, other things equal, be expeditiously removed.

I appreciate your outreach and the opportunity to explain our current read of the EO, realizing that this is a fast evolving process. CBP will follow the EO while treating all with dignity and respect.

I'm a staff attorney at the Asian Law Caucus, a non-profit in San Francisco. We are getting many calls from people confused if the EO applies to them and if they should board flights. I am writing to follow up on my colleague (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) email regarding the detention of two individuals at SFO, and to reiterate that their removal would both violate the stay issued by the Eastern District and the underlying statutory and constitutional protections on which the stay is based.

I just spoke to CBP Supervisors (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) at SFO and attempted to give them G 28s for these individuals, but they refused to accept them or tell me where to file them. They directed me to the CBP public affairs website and I am CCing the Headquarters Branch Chief as well. I attach my g 28.

We urgently request information about the status of these clients and reiterate the unlawful nature of their removal.
