Authority:

U.S Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is authorized to collect the information requested on this form pursuant to 19 U.S.C. 1485, and provided for by 19 CFR 24.11 and 141.20.

Purpose:

CBP is requesting this collection of information to be used by CBP to ensure that additional duties are not imposed on the importer. The information on this form is used to validate an importer's claim for such duty allowances from the owner of imported merchandise.

Routine Uses:

The information requested on this form may be shared externally, as a "routine use" with appropriate federal, state, local, tribal, or foreign governmental agencies, or multilateral governmental organizations, to assist DHS in investigating or prosecuting the violations of, or for enforcing or implementing, a statute, rule, regulation, order, license, or treaty or when DHS determines that the information would assist in the enforcement of civil or criminal laws.
