Inspection services for the entrance/ arrival of aircraft at Charleston International Airport are available 7 days per week, 0630-2130 in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures.

Permission to Land Procedures

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departure from the foreign port or place and at least two hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at Charleston International Airport.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside these parameters, previously granted permission(s) are invalid and you must contact the CBP port to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Aircraft will taxi to Charlie Ramp.
- CBP Officer(s) will meet the aircraft on the ramp to begin inspection.
- Be prepared to present passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration, and user fee decal (if appropriate).
- Crew and passengers will be processed plane side.
- If required by CBP, crew and passengers can be processed inside the FIS.
- Regulated waste/garbage must be collected at the FBO.
