**Did you know** CBP’s Child Care Subsidy Program offers financial assistance to help cover your child care expenses? Please visit **CBP Employee and Family Resources: Child Care** to find out if you qualify.

To take advantage of the CBP Child Care Subsidy Program, you must **choose** child care providers that are **licensed and/or regulated** by the state or local authorities in the service area.



## ELIGIBLE CARE MAY INCLUDE\*

- ✓ **CENTER-BASED CHILD CARE:**
  - Federally sponsored child care centers
  - Non-federal child care centers
- ✓ **HOME-BASED CHILD CARE:**
  - Au pairs
  - Family child care homes\*
  - Professional nannies\*

*\*This includes regulated family members or friends*

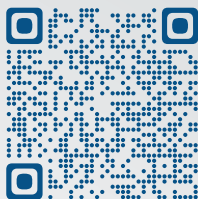


## TYPES OF CARE COVERED

- ✓ Daytime summer programs

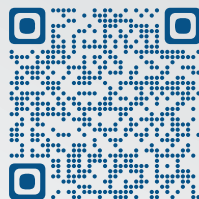

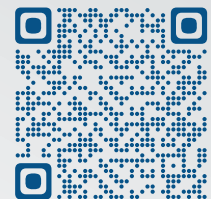
