Hours of Service for Entrance and Clearance

Inspection services for the entrance/ arrival of aircraft at Northeast Florida Regional Airport Saint Augustine are available during regular port hours 1200-2000, Thursday-Monday in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures.

Commercial aircraft operators departing the U.S. must obtain an outbound clearance by contacting CBP directly.

Permission to Land Procedures

Northeast Florida Regional Airport Saint Augustine Airport (KSGJ) is designated as a "user fee airport" [19 CFR 122.1(m);19 CFR 122.15].

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP 24-72 hours prior to departure from the foreign port or place.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside these parameters, previously granted permission(s) are invalid and you must contact the CBP port to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Taxi off runway in front of the CBP inspection station.
- Await instructions from the CBP Officer.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- Inspection services outside the hours of 1200-2000 and for Tuesdays/Wednesdays may be covered by the Port of Jacksonville or by KSGJ personnel on overtime.
- All service requests regardless of arrival date/time need to be requested in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures by contacting the KSGJ CBP Officer on duty by telephone and/or email.
