

# Document Image System (DIS) Vehicle Export Document Submission via EDI

Last updated: August 19, 2024



On September 28, 2024, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will deploy enhancements to the Document Image System (DIS) to facilitate vehicle-related document submission via Electronic Data Interchange (EDI). As a reminder, today importers and exporters can use DIS to submit vehicle-related documents to CBP via EDI. This enhancement improves data submission for used vehicle exports.

## What will change for trade users?

- This enhancement will enable EDI filers to provide additional optional metadata when submitting the following Document Label Code:  
*Vehicle\_Title\_Certificates*
- The optional metadata that may be provided include:
  - Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)
  - Product Identification Number (PIN)
  - Point of contact (POC) name
  - POC email address
  - POC phone number
- In addition, if a filer submits a document that meets the following conditions:
  - Document Label Code = *Vehicle\_Title\_Certificates*
  - Transaction Type = *ITN*
  - No VIN or PIN provided,

DIS can accept the document and will return the following reminder response message: *If this is a submission for a used vehicle export, please include a VIN or a PIN.*
