Document Image System (DIS) Vehicle Export Document Submission via EDI

On September 28, 2024, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will deploy enhancements to the Document Image System (DIS) to facilitate vehicle-related document submission via Electronic Data Interchange (EDI). As a reminder, today importers and exporters can use DIS to submit vehicle-related documents to CBP via EDI. This enhancement improves data submission for used vehicle exports.

What will change for trade users?

- This enhancement will enable EDI filers to provide additional optional metadata when submitting the following Document Label Code: Vehicle Title Certificates
- The optional metadata that may be provided include:
 - o Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)
 - o Product Identification Number (PIN)
 - o Point of contact (POC) name
 - o POC email address
 - o POC phone number
- In addition, if a filer submits a document that meets the following conditions:
 - o Document Label Code = Vehicle Title Certificates
 - \circ Transaction Type = ITN
 - o No VIN or PIN provided,

DIS can accept the document and will return the following reminder response message: *If this is a submission for a used vehicle export, please include a VIN or a PIN.*
