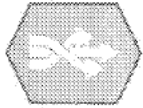

Please find the final Del Rio Mass Migration Event AAR attached.

Total costs are estimated at ~ \$25M. And total lost import value due to POE closure is estimated at ~\$45M.

The seventeen (17) day Mass Migration Event (MME) required a whole of government response to ensure the safety, rapid transport, and efficient processing of migrants from 58 different countries that illegally crossed into the United States and congregated under the Del Rio Port of Entry International Bridge. The MME was unlike anything that CBP had encountered in its history and at its peak, 14,921 migrants were staged under the bridge. In total, some 19,752 migrants were taken into custody. CBP temporary holding facilities were already over capacity and local resources were inadequate to manage the speed and volume of migrants flowing into the United States. State, Local, and Community partners responded to CBP's support request and exhausted all available resources to assist in managing the event. All Southwest Border Patrol Sectors assisted by sending personnel and resources to Del Rio and hundreds of Border Patrol agents and CBP officers from across the country arrived to assist.

A massive effort to care for the migrant's safety and basic needs was underway as ground and air transportation relocated thousands of migrants to facilities across the Southwest Border for processing. This unprecedented historical response to the MME successfully prevented any loss of life and treated hundreds of migrants in need of medical assistance. The Office of Field Operations played a key role in assisting the Border Patrol and in the closure of the Port of Entry was the turning point that increased safety and gained a greater response from the Government of Mexico and officials in the National Capital Region. The response by the State of Texas and the surge of Department of Public Safety Troopers was monumental.

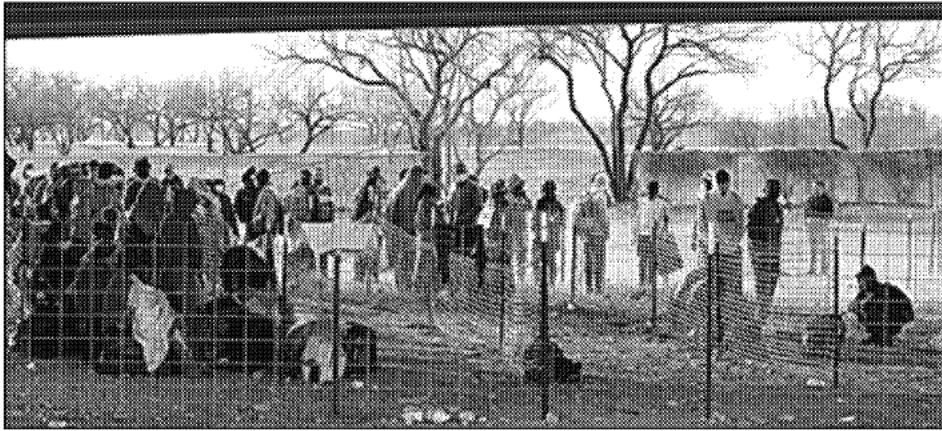

- There are no CBP officers assisting BP DRT with migrants under the bridge.

BLUF: Single source reporting indicates Haitian migrants are messaging other migrants in Piedras Negras and Acuna to build up enough numbers in those locations to overwhelm CBP resources.

Amplification:

1. Single source reporting indicates a (b)(7)(E) official has stated there is a heavy build up of migrants in Acuna.

2. Single source reporting indicates Cubans and Venezuelans are not inclined to enter MPP and our assessment is they will attempt to illegally enter the US.

3. Single source reporting indicates Mexican and Central American migrants view MPP as a hinderance. However, they believe they will receive medical care, food, water, and shelter while waiting in Mexico and they are more likely to enter MPP.

4. Single source reporting indicates Haitians are not likely to enter MPP because they think they may be returned to Haiti and they do not want to extend their stay in Mexico any longer. Single source reporting also indicates Haitians are messaging other migrants in Piedras Negras and Acuna that if they build up enough numbers in those specific locations they will be able to overwhelm CBP resources in Piedras Negras and Acuna.

5. Single source reporting is stating there are a number of migrant online forums and chat groups which are discussing moving from Acuna to Piedras Negras due to perceived ease of entry into the US from Piedras Negras. (b)(7)(E)

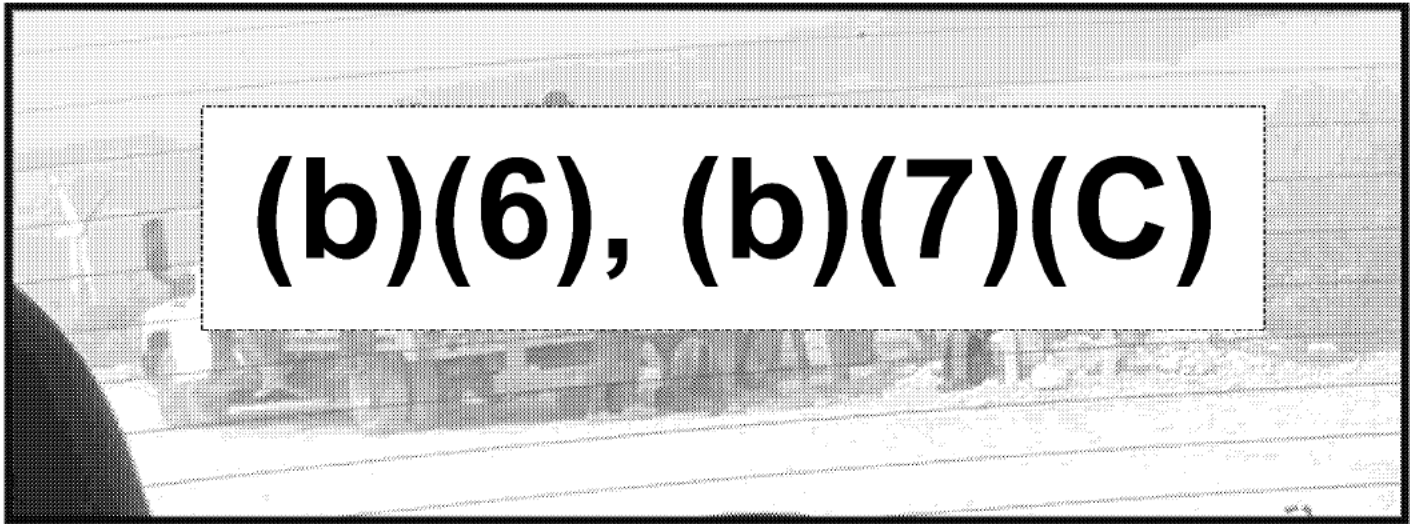

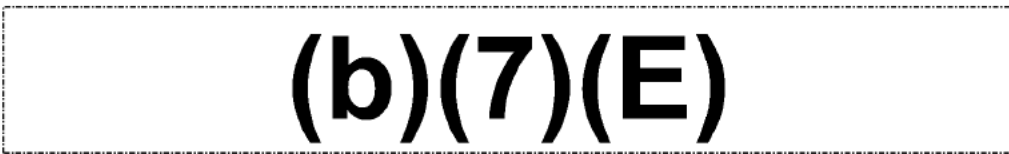
