**Situational Awareness**

**Del Rio, TX: Large Group of Migrants Gathered Beneath the International Bridge - Media Interest**

- On November 28, 2021, at 0715 CST, US Customs and Border Protection (CBP) management at the Del Rio, TX Port of Entry were notified by the City Of Del Rio toll booth staff that approximately 200 migrants seeking asylum were gathered beneath the Del Rio International Bridge.
- The migrants claimed to be traveling from Ciudad Acuna, Coahuila, Mexico and crossed the river to seek asylum in the United States.
- CBP officers were immediately dispatched to cover the federal inspection area (FIS) and the port perimeter area.
- One male Cuban migrant was encountered in the FIS and claimed to have climbed the City toll booth fence to request asylum at the bridge.
- The Cuban national was transported to Passport Control Secondary for processing.
- The U.S. Border Patrol Del Rio Station (BP) was contacted, arrived, and escorted the group beneath the bridge to an area to await transportation for processing.
- BP advised that (b)(7)(E) transportation of the migrants would take a few hours. In the interim, BP is monitoring the group.
- Currently, there is no impact to operations or injuries reported.
- This event has garnered national media attention.
- The CBP Laredo Operations Center will monitor the situation and provide updates accordingly.

For situational awareness, please see below regarding mass migrant situation that occurred in the Eagle Pass, Texas area.

On September 20, 2023, at approximately 1030 hours, Border Patrol Agents in Del Rio Sector (Eagle Pass Station) advised they had multiple groups crossing the river underneath Port of Entry #2 in Eagle Pass, Texas. Initial reports from multiple sources indicated there were four to five thousand migrants in route to POE #2. (b)(7)(E) engaged with their counterparts from the Government of Mexico (GOM) and confirmed there were approximately 2,200 migrants walking towards the river.

After a couple of hours, a total of approximately 2,600 undocumented migrants congregated under the international bridge near the Eagle Pass Port of Entry #2. Del Rio Sector personnel deployed all available manpower and resources and collaborated with multiple stakeholders to intake the undocumented migrants, and safely transport them to the Del Rio Sector Soft Sided Processing Facility (SSPF) in Eagle Pass, Texas.

Del Rio Sector has been coordinating with multiple Southwest Border Sectors for assistance with decompressing some of the most vulnerable populations to include unaccompanied juveniles and family units. Assistance from other sectors is limited as their current in-custody numbers are also elevated due to the increasing number of undocumented migrant encounters throughout the Southwest Border.

Below are some of the lines of effort being executed to help in managing the current situation.

- The mayor of Eagle Pass signed and issued an Emergency Declaration due to the migrant surge, which will be in effect for a period of 7 days.
- CBP Office of Field Operations is supporting operations underneath POE#2.
- Del Rio Sector has deployed their tactical infrastructure team to support with logistics requirements.
- All available transportation assets to include from (b)(7)(E) Sectors, were re-deployed to Eagle Pass, Texas to provide transportation support.
- OFO in Eagle Pass, Texas is implementing a Stage 4 Emergency
  - Port of Entry #1 will be closing today at 6PM
  - Railroad Gate/Entrance near POE#2 has been closed since approximately 3PM
  - OFO stated both will remain closed until further notice
  - OFO personnel was reassigned to assist with the intake and security needs at the Del Rio Sector SSPF.

Currently there are approximately 200 undocumented migrants under the international bridge still waiting to be transported to the Del Rio Sector SSPF. Del Rio Sector is actively engaged with all stakeholders to include GOM in confirming additional waves of migrants traveling into the border area near Del Rio Sector and/or other sectors along the Southwest Border.

The seventeen (17) day Mass Migration Event (MME) required a whole of government response to ensure the safety, rapid transport, and efficient processing of migrants from 58 different countries that illegally crossed into the United States and congregated under the Del Rio Port of Entry International Bridge. The MME was unlike anything that CBP had encountered in its history and at its peak, 14,921 migrants were staged under the bridge. In total, some 19,752 migrants were taken into custody (b)(7)(E)

A massive effort to care for the migrant's safety and basic needs was underway as ground and air transportation relocated thousands of migrants to facilities across the Southwest Border for processing.
