The seventeen (17) day Mass Migration Event (MME) required a whole of government response to ensure the safety, rapid transport, and efficient processing of migrants from 58 different countries that illegally crossed into the United States and congregated under the Del Rio Port of Entry International Bridge. The MME was unlike anything that CBP had encountered in its history and at its peak, 14,921 migrants were staged under the bridge. In total, some 19,752 migrants were taken into custody.

They will have 20 TXDPS Highway Patrol Units and 20 military Humvees along with a Mexican state police presence of 40-50 units on the Mexican side conducting mirrored patrols.
