Please find the final Del Rio Mass Migration Event AAR attached.

Total costs are estimated at (b)(7)(E) And total lost import value due to POE closure is estimated at (b)(7)(E)

The seventeen (17) day Mass Migration Event (MME) required a whole of government response to ensure the safety, rapid transport, and efficient processing of migrants from 58 different countries that illegally crossed into the United States and congregated under the Del Rio Port of Entry International Bridge. The MME was unlike anything that CBP had encountered in its history and at its peak, 14,921 migrants were staged under the bridge. In total, some 19,752 migrants were taken into custody. (b)(7)(E)

A massive effort to care for the migrant's safety and basic needs was underway as ground and air transportation relocated thousands of migrants to facilities across the Southwest Border for processing. This unprecedented historical response to the MME successfully prevented any loss of life and treated hundreds of migrants in need of medical assistance. (b)(7)(E)

Good morning,

Below is the approved statement we received from USBP, CBP, and DHS. This is what we are provided to media when we receive an inquiry.

**CBP Statement**

Migrants are congregating under the Del Rio International Bridge while they wait to turn themselves in to the U.S. Border Patrol (USBP), where they will be transported to Del Rio Sector USBP facilities for intake and processing. Drinking water, towels, and portable toilets have been delivered for migrants to use while they wait to be transported to a facility. The vast majority of single adults and many families will continue to be expelled under the CDC's Title 42 authority, and those who cannot be expelled under Title 42 and do not have a legal basis to remain will be processed under Title 8 authorities.

**On Background:**

Persons taken into Border Patrol custody for immigration processing are evaluated on a case-by-case basis for custodial determinations. U.S. legal requirements, COVID-19 protocols, holding capacity, and the health conditions of the persons in custody are all factors that affect such determinations.




- Thousands of migrants are awaiting detention underneath the Del Rio International Bridge on Wednesday
  - According to a media reporter, the number of migrants has increased to 7,007, an increase from about 4,000 earlier in the day
  - The City of Del Rio, Val Verde County, the Texas Department of State Health Services, and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security are working together to provide more manpower and resources to the Del Rio Border Patrol Sector
  - Authorities are trying to protect the migrants from heat-related illness by putting them in the shaded area
    - Media is told it's a temporary staging site where migrants wait to be taken into CPB custody
  - Media is reporting that a majority of the migrants are of Haitian origin
