On August 10, 2019, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Officers assigned to (b)(7)(E) (b)(7)(E) at Boston Logan International Airport (BOS) encountered a 30-year old male citizen of Iran who arrived from Doha, Qatar. (b)(7)(E)

(b)(7)(E) At conclusion of secondary exam, the subject was found to be inadmissible to the U.S. pursuant to Sections 212(a)(7)(A)(i)(I) and 212(a)(6)(C)(i) of the INA and was processed as an expedited removal.

Details:

On (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) CBP Officers assigned to (b)(7)(E) at Boston Logan International Airport encountered Amin (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) COC: Iran), who arrived on board Qatar Airways (QR) flight 743 from Doha, Qatar (DOH) with travel originating in Tehran, Iran (IKA).

An arriving alien remains such even if paroled pursuant to section 212(d)(5) of the Act, except that an alien who was paroled before April 1, 1997, or an alien who was granted advance parole which the alien applied for and obtained in the United States prior to the alien's departure from and return to the United States, shall not be considered an arriving alien for purposes of section 235(b)(1)(A)(i) of the Act

Section 235(b)(1)(A)(i) is the provision of the INA that authorizes issuance of an expedited removal order for arriving aliens deemed to be inadmissible pursuant to 212(a)(7) and 212(a)(6).

Boston, MA: Citizen of Saudi Arabia found in Possession of Extremist Media Refused entry at Boston Logan Airport

Summary:

On **(b)(6), (b)(7)(C)** U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Officers assigned to Boston Logan Airport encountered a 19 year old male citizen of Saudi Arabia (UAE) that applied for admission on a F1 student visa. During the course **(b)(7)(E)** secondary inspection radical extremist media was discovered on his cell phone. The subject was determined to be inadmissible into the United States pursuant to INA section 212(a)(7)(A)(i)(I) (immigrant without immigrant visa) and was refused entry.

Details:

On Sunday (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) at approximately 1545 hours (EST) CBP Officers assigned to Boston Logan Airport encountered (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (COC: Saudi Arabia) after he arrived aboard Emirates Airlines flight 237 from Dubai, United Arab Emirates.

(b)(6), (b)(7)(C) presented a valid Saudi Arabian passport and F1 visa to the primary officer and was admitted. After collecting his checked luggage (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was met by members of the Boston (b)(7)(E)

After a brief interview (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was escorted to secondary where (b)(7)(E) secondary inspection and interview was conducted.

During the course of the (b)(7)(E) secondary inspection (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated that he was currently a student in Saudi Arabia and was coming the United States to attend English school in (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)

A review of (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) cell phone (b)(7)(E) media including several pictures of (b)(7)(E)

When asked about the pictures (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) stated that some of them were sent to via the "WhatsApp" and from friends.
