USCIS Extends Green Card Validity Extension to 36 Months for Green Card Renewals

- Effective September 10, 2024, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) started to automatically extend the validity of Permanent Resident Cards (also known as Green Cards) to 36 months for lawful permanent residents who file Form I-90, Application to Replace Permanent Resident Card.
- These receipt notices can be presented with an expired Green Card as evidence of continued status.
- By presenting the updated receipt notice with the expired Green Card, the traveler is authorized to work and travel for 36 months from the expiration date on the front of the expired Green Card.
