Inspection services for the entrance/ arrival of aircraft at KBHM are available Monday-Friday, 0900-1700 in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures (see special procedures below).

Commercial aircraft operators departing the U.S. must obtain an outbound clearance by contacting CBP directly.

Permission to Land Procedures

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP no later than 24 hours in advance of intended arrival.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside those parameters, Previously granted permission(s) are invalid and you must contact CBP to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Aircraft are cleared at the FBOs or at private hangars.
- Be prepared to present passports, visas, pilots license, medical certificate, aircraft registration, and user fee decal.
- Regulated waste/garbage is disposed of in the red garbage cans located at the FBOs/ private hangars.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- Requests for service for after hours flight arrivals must be received as far in advance as possible but no later than 24 hours in advance of intended arrival.
- Requests for service on Saturday, Sunday, or holidays that fall on a Monday must be received no later than 1430 hours on the preceding Friday.
