Hours of Service for Entrance and Clearance

Inspection services for the entrance/ arrival of aircraft at Duluth International Airport are available 7 days per week, 0700-2300 in accordance with the port's permission to land procedures. This includes federal holidays.

Commercial aircraft operators departing the U.S. must obtain an outbound clearance by contacting CBP directly.

Permission to Land Procedures

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departure from the foreign port or place and at 48 hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at Duluth International Airport.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside those parameters, Previously granted permission(s) are invalid and you must contact CBP to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Aircraft should park on the ramp at the FIS.
- A CBP Officer will meet the aircraft on the ramp to begin the inspection process.
- All crew and passengers will be processed inside the FIS.
- Please be prepared to present passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration and user fee decal (if appropriate).
- Crew should ensure access to the baggage hold prior to debarking the aircraft.
- Regulated waste/garbage will be collected by CBP from the aircraft crew.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- Please call (218) 720-5203 during office hours to arrange all CBP services.
- Advance notice of arrival will ensure that a CBP officer will be available to provide timely service. Additionally, all permissions to land may be received via e-mail at duluthport@cbp.dhs.gov, in addition to subsequent updates of ETA.
