Permission to Land Procedures

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP
prior to departure from the foreign port or place and at least
24 hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at
Antonio Rivera Rodriguez Airport.

Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-)
30 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside those
parameters, Previously granted permission(s) are invalid
and you must contact CBP to re-secure permission to land.

Inspection Process

- Aircraft should park inside the yellow circle in front of the CBP Office.
- A CBP Officer will meet the aircraft on the ramp to begin the inspection.
- All crew and passengers will be processed inside the FIS area with a maximum capacity of eight (8) people.
- Be prepared to present for inspection passports, visas, pilot's license, medical certificate, aircraft registration, and user fee decal (if appropriate), including luggage and personal items.
- There is USDA compliance agreement in place at this airport for the collection of regulated waste/garbage.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

- To allow time for processing at TJVQ, aircraft operators should schedule to arrive on or before 1630 hours.
- Aircraft arriving after 1630 hours and before 1730 should plan to arrive at Jose Aponte Hernandez Airport (TJRV) which provides services until 1730 hrs. and after 1730 hours should plan to arrive at the Luis Munoz Marin International Airport (TJSJ) which provides services 24/7.
- Advise CBP if transporting live animals, weapons, hunting trophies, or commercial imports.
- Passengers are not allowed to board the aircraft at the CBP Inspection area marked by a circle.
- Processing of cargo is not permitted at TJVQ.
