Interceptor Class 41-Foot SAFE Boat Coastal Interceptor Vessel

The 41-foot Secure Around Flotation Equipped (SAFE) Boat is used by U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Air and Marine Operations (AMO) in coastal waters to combat maritime smuggling and defend the waterways along our nation's borders from terrorism.

With its advanced hull design, safety equipment and electronics, this vessel provides agents with the protection, mobility, and reliability to intercept and apprehend maritime smugglers.

A 41-foot SAFE Boat 3-person (minimum) crew works together with AMO's aviation assets and other federal, state, and local law enforcement entities to accomplish the homeland security mission.
