Commercial Customs Operations Advisory Committee (COAC) Next Generation Facilitation Subcommittee E-Commerce Task Force Draft Recommendation *

 COAC recommends that in order to track the growth and development of §321 transactions, enhance and improve the use of CBP and trade resources including transaction data, increase facilitation and enforcement as well as consider alternatives to detentions and seizures, that CBP quarterly compile & report statistics of all shipments which receive CBP §321 release via either Manifest Release as well as Entry Type 86. CBP should segregate statistics by express, postal, non-express air, non-express sea, nonexpress truck.
