THE CBP HIRING PROCESS: Frontline Positions

Job Application

The process begins when a candidate applies to open positions on USA

Conditional Offer

A review of the exam, resume, and other materials results in a conditional offer, if successful

Medical Exam & Qualifications

The medical exam includes a medical history review, physician exam, and a vision and hearing test

Structured Interview

The structured interview gauges decision-making, emotional maturity, and other skills for the position

Background Investigation

The background investigation verifies candidates' information and references to ensure suitability

Final Offer

The final offer
is extended
following the
completion of all
hiring process steps

Entrance Exam

The "Candidate
Experience Record" asks
about prior experiences
followed by a Reasoning
Entrance Exam

Background Investigation Form

The Federal Government's digital portal used to gather information to conduct background investigations

Physical Fitness Test

The physical fitness test ensures the candidate can perform the required actions of the position

Polygraph Exam

The polygraph assessment verifies that the candidate will be a responsible and reliable member of the team

Drug Test

The drug test ensures that there are no concerns of controlled substance use for the candidate
