

Regulated Biological Materials

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) and partner government agencies regulate the importation of biological materials that can pose a threat to agriculture, public health, and natural resources.

Per CBP regulations, all biological materials must be declared by providing an oral declaration or by using a self-service kiosk, mobile application, or CBP Form 6059B.
