San Ysidro, Ca – AEU Officers Transport Iraqi LPR Detainee to Hospital for Chest Pains.

SUMMARY:

On Sunday, January 29, 2017 at approximately 0800 hours, an Iraqi detainee claimed to have chest pains. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) evaluated the subject and advised (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) be transported to the hospital due to an elevated heartbeat. The detainee was transported to SHARP – Chula Vista for evaluation.

DETAILS:

- On January 28, 2017 at approximately 0530 hours, a male identified as (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (07/20/1970) applied for admission at the San Ysidro Port of Entry pedestrian lanes.
- (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) presented his Legal Permanent Resident Card (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) to the primary officer and stated he was going (b)(6), (b)(7)(C)
- (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was referred to the Admissibility Enforcement Unit due to the Executive Order signed by POTUS.
- During the secondary processing it was discerned that (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) had a 2011 felony conviction for assault with a deadly weapon. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) was placed in 240 removal proceedings.
- On January 29, 2017 at approximately 0800 hrs, (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) claimed to have chest pains.

- (b)(6) responded and after completing an evaluation recommended (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) be taken Sharp Medical Center for an EKG evaluation.
- CBPO (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) and CBPO (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) escorted (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) to the hospital.
- The nurse at Sharp Hospital stated (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) needs to be monitored due to existing heart conditions. The chest pains may be due to a blockage in a previous placed stent.
- (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) will be admitted for observations and a hospital watch has been set up by the scheduling office.

On January 29, 2017; San Diego County Regional Airport Authority (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) arrived at the CBP FIS and stated that a peaceful protest was taking place at San Diego International Airport at approximately 1700 hours (Local).

Details:

- At approximately 1615 hrs. a small group of approximately 5 protestors gathered in front of terminal 2 near the FIS. After several minutes, the group relocated to Terminal 2 West – arrivals- near Delta Airlines.
- At approximately 1630 hrs. (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) notified (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) that (b)(7)(E)
- 1700 hrs. approximately 100 protestors have gathered, increasing their numbers.
- Location of protestors is curbside arrivals- lower level- at Terminal 2 (west) near Delta Airlines. Protesters location is currently (b)(7)(E)
- CBP personnel verified the presence of local media covering the event. Channel 5 news and KUSI are present.

SYNOPSIS:

On January 28, 2017, various U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) ports of entry (POEs) are reporting protests resulting from the Executive Order (EO) “Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States” issued by President Trump on January 27, 2017. This EO suspended all entry into the United States for aliens who are nationals from Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria and Yemen as per Section 212(f) of the INA. This includes all non-immigrant classifications, with the exception of those people traveling on diplomatic visas, NATO visas, C2 visas going to the United Nations, G1, G2, G3 and G4 visas. The order also includes all immigrant classes of admission, returning resident aliens, refugees and asylees.

- As of 2135 hours, JFK Terminal 4 is reporting that the crowds of protesters are decreasing at this time.
