

SYNOPSIS:

On January 28, 2017, various U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) ports of entry (POEs) are reporting protests resulting from the Executive Order (EO) "Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States" issued by President Trump on January 27, 2017. This EO suspended all entry into the United Sates for aliens who are nationals from Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria and Yemen as per Section 212(f) of the INA. This includes all non-immigrant classifications, with the exception of those people traveling on diplomatic visas, NATO visas, C2 visas going to the United Nations, G1, G2, G3 and G4 visas. The order also includes all immigrant classes of admission, returning resident aliens, refugees and asylees.
