

OFO recommends that you (b)(5), (b)(6), (b)(7)(C), (b)(7)(E) Executive Order entitled, "Protecting the Nation from Foreign Terrorist Entry into the United States" [January 28, 2017] to (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) (D/POB: (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia), a fourteen year old male, citizen and national of Syria, arrived at John F. Kennedy International Airport aboard Saudi Arabian Airlines (SV) flight SV-21 from Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. The Port of Entry has done a thorough exam on this individual and vetting indicates there is no nexus to terrorism. Due to the lack of any indication of a security risk, the potential claims of fear of returning to his country of nationality, and the fact that he is a minor, we recommend that this individual be admitted consistent with Section 3(g) of the Executive Order.
