About 200 Canadian permanent residents who had their Nexus cards revoked because of the Trump immigration ban have had their trusted-traveller passes reinstated.

In a statement Wednesday, Public Safety Minister Ralph Goodale said the reinstatements were confirmed by U.S. officials, who have been in regular contact with their Canadian counterparts.

"Some 200 Canadian permanent residents had their Nexus cards revoked a few days ago because the recent presidential executive order rendered them ineligible. But now that the order stands suspended, those 200 Nexus cards have been reinstated, pending further court decisions yet to come," Mr. Goodale said.

"The government of Canada continues to work to ensure all Canadians are treated in a fair and expeditious manner."

U.S. President Donald Trump recently ordered a 90-day ban on the entry of people from seven Muslim-majority countries: Iran, Iraq, Syria, Sudan, Libya, Yemen and Somalia. Shortly after, some Nexus card holders in Canada reported their cards being revoked.

Mr. Goodale noted that the situation is "complex" due to a recent judicial suspension of the executive order and the appeal of that suspension. He said Nexus card holders who feel they have been treated unfairly by the eligibility decisions taken by the U.S. government can seek recourse by calling (202) 325-8000.

Nexus cards give "low-risk, preapproved travellers" preclearance at designated ports of entry when travelling between Canada and the United States, allowing them to avoid long lineups and waiting times.

In order to become a Nexus member, applicants must go through a rigorous screening process, including an application form, where they provide information about their work, travel and residence history, and an inperson interview with a Canada Border Services Agency or U.S. Customs and Border Protection officer. Applicants pay a \$50 processing fee for a

five-year membership; for children under the age of 18, it's free. As of December, 2016, there were 1.49 million members in the Nexus program - the majority of whom are Canadians, according to the CBSA.

Toronto lawyer Cyndee Todgham Cherniak said she has heard from several Canadians and some permanent residents in Canada who have had their Nexus cards revoked since the Trump directive was signed. She said some of the individuals have dual citizenship with one of the seven countries named in Mr. Trump's immigration ban while others only have Canadian citizenship, with no ties to any of the affected countries.

As of Wednesday, she said none of her clients had told her that their Nexus cards had been reinstated.

Last week, Ms. Todgham Cherniak said each of the individuals received a letter from U.S. Customs and Border Protection telling them they were no longer eligible for Nexus membership, with no further details provided.

Because none of them have broken customs or immigration laws, provided false information or been convicted of any crimes, she said she can only assume that they have been deemed by the United States to be not of "good character," a determination that can be made by U.S. officials to strip an individual's Nexus membership.

"The U.S. must be taking the position that if you come from one of these seven countries, then you're no longer a good character," Ms. Todgham Cherniak said.

"It's nothing that they've done, an action that they've taken - it's based on where they were born."

Mr. Goodale said last week that there is an appeal process in place for people who feel they have been treated unfairly in having their Nexus cards revoked. However, Ms. Todgham Cherniak said that process is not simple for Canadians, as it often takes months for the U.S. ombudsman to respond to complaints and little transparency is provided. She called on Mr. Goodale to intervene directly.

"What would be preferable would be to have Minister Goodale work with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to have a fair, transparent [appeal] process."

Immigration Minister Ahmed Hussen has said the government received assurances from the United States that Canadian dual citizens and permanent residents in Canada who are citizens of one of the seven countries named in the ban will still be allowed to cross the border. However, a State Department official added last week that permanent residents of Canada who hold passports of a restricted country must obtain a visa to enter the United States and can only do so through a Canadian land border or port of entry with preclearance services.



# **NEXUS** cards reportedly revoked in wake of Trump travel ban

Public Safety Minister Ralph Goodale says the government is trying to ensure Canadian dual-nationals can still use their Nexus cards at the border following word that cards have been revoked.

Editor's note: A previous version of this story stated that NEXUS is only available to Canadian citizens. The pass is also available to permanent residents.

Certain NEXUS card holders in the United States and Canada are being advised to temporarily avoid using the preclearance system after reports of travellers having their status revoked.

Two Toronto-based immigration lawyers have confirmed to Global News that they've received calls from people who have lost their NEXUS memberships — seemingly without violating any border rules — since Jan. 27, when U.S. President Donald Trump signed an executive order on immigration.

Government officials have also confirmed they are aware of similar reports.

Almost all of the cases reported to lawyers Stephen Green and Cyndee Todgham Cherniak have involved NEXUS members who hold citizenship in one of the countries affected by the Trump travel ban. But all of them also hold citizenship or permanent residency in either Canada or the United States, which is a prerequisite for the NEXUS program.

"This is something that is quite inexplicable," said Todgham Cherniak, adding that the number of cases now extends "beyond coincidence."

NEXUS allows a faster transition through airport screening for trusted travellers, who must apply to join. Applicants are subject to extensive screening, including in-person interviews, employment checks, travel history checks, criminal background checks and other verifications before they receive their card.

"Anyone who applied for NEXUS has gone through extreme vetting," said Todgham Cherniak.

Green said he thinks that the rules surrounding the travel ban still haven't been communicated well enough, meaning individual border guards are reacting to it in different ways.

"It hasn't gotten down to the people on the ground implementing the policy," he said.

Trump's executive order placed a 90-day ban on entry into the United States for nationals of seven predominantly Muslim countries – Iran, Iraq, Libya, Syria, Somalia, Sudan and Yemen.

Dual nationals are exempt from the ban, officials have confirmed, but NEXUS members on both sides of the border who hold citizenship in one of those Middle Eastern countries should avoid crossing if possible, said Todgham Cherniak.

"Wait until things settle down a little bit," she advised.

"If you don't have to travel to the United States, if you're flying overseas, don't fly through LaGuardia (airport), fly Air Canada direct to London or Hong Kong or wherever it is you're going."

Green agreed that it's best to stay away from the border, adding that the two people who contacted his office had their NEXUS membership revoked as they attempted to cross.

"Don't enter the United Stated yet, and don't leave the United States if you're there with your NEXUS pass, until it becomes clear," he advised travellers with dual-citizenship from one of the seven nations.

#### 'No longer of good character'?

But even staying home may not prevent headaches. According to Todgham Cherniak, the five cases that she has seen were people who had not travelled at all within the past week. They simply received a letter advising them their NEXUS membership was now invalid because they "no longer meet eligibility requirements."

That's a standard form letter, she noted, and she sees it all the time.

"Usually it's when someone has breached a customs law, or they've breached a rule of the NEXUS program, every so often someone's been arrested so they no longer meet eligibility requirements."

But another basis for revocation, rarely used by officials, is that the card-holder is "no longer of good character." That may be what's happening to people with these particular dual-nationalities.

Revoking a NEXUS membership is entirely left to the discretion of border officials in Canada and the U.S.

Public Safety Minister Ralph Goodale said Friday in the House of Commons that anyone who has their NEXUS membership revoked can appeal to an ombudsman in Canada.

"If people feel that they have been in fact unfairly treated by the process on either side of the border there is an appeal process," Goodale said.

"Obviously on a governmental level we will be working with our American counterparts to make sure that rules are properly and fairly administered, and that Canadians have the access they are entitled to with a Canadian passport."

Todgham Cherniak acknowledged that there is a two-step appeal process in Canada, but appealing any NEXUS decisions made by the U.S. can be very time-consuming and often fruitless.

"It does take time, and it does take money," she said.
